In accordance with Section 5120.10 of the Ohio Revised Code and Executive Order 92-03 of the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Stark County Jail a Full-Service Jail, was inspected on Thursday, March 27, 2008.

The inspection was restricted to assessing compliance with a group of standards selected from the Minimum Standards for Jails in Ohio promulgated by the Bureau of Adult Detention. Please note that this inspection does not reflect a comprehensive evaluation of the overall jail condition. The inspection consisted of the jail inspector receiving and/or reviewing requested documentation and/or materials, touring selected areas of the jail, and having a brief interview with selected jail personnel.
